GHS Classifications:

- Physical, Flammable Aerosols, 1
- Physical, Gases Under Pressure, Liquefied Gas
- Health, Aspiration hazard, 1
- Health, Respiratory or skin sensitization, 1

- Health, Serious Eye Damage/Eye Irritation, 2 A

GHS Phrases:

- H222 - Extremely flammable aerosol
- H280 - Contains gas under pressure; may explode if heated
- H304 - May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways
- H317 - May cause an allergic skin reaction
- H315 - Causes skin irritation
- H319 - Causes serious eye irritation

GHS Precautionary Statements:

- P102 - Keep out of reach of children.
- P103 - Read label and SDS before use.
- P210 - Keep away from heat/sparks/open flames/hot surfaces. No smoking
- P211 - Do not spray on an open flame or other ignition source.
- P251 - Pressurized container: Do not pierce or burn, even after use.
- P261 - Avoid breathing mist/spray.
- P264 - Wash hands thoroughly after handling.
- P272 - Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace.

- P305+351+338 - IF IN EYES: Rinse continuously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do.

Continue rinsing.

- P337 - If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
- P403 - Store in a well ventilated place.
- P410+412 - Protect from sunlight. Do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50 °C/122 °F
- P405 - Store locked up.
- P501 - Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations.

4	FIRST AID MEASURES
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- Inhalation:** Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Call a poison center or a doctor if you feel unwell.
